Sub : Non filers Monitoring System (NMS) – Time Barring Action – reg.

Your kind attention is invited to Non-filers of IT Returns and the processing of data (NMS-1st Cycle) at the level of Assessing Officers now under consideration keeping in view of Time Barring action. It has come to our notice that at present the 1st cycle of NMS where thousands of data is available in the Assessing Officers window including matters relating to FY 2010-11 in which action may be required to be taken before the time barring date i.e. 31st March, 2017.


2. No uniform or consistent directions have been issued to the Field Charges leaving the Assessing Officers in great trouble with voluminous records of data pushed into their system with limited number of days available before closure of current fiscal year.
3. The NMS data is in itaxnet and not linked to current / present PAN jurisdiction. Adding fuel to the fire, though it is possible to migrate PAN of Cycle 1 NMS Data to the correct jurisdiction but the data cannot be migrated to the present AO holding jurisdiction over the case.
4. In the circumstances, the Assessing Officers have no option but to transfer the data offline or paper format or through email from one jurisdiction to the other. The Officers would be compelled to utilize the in-complete information being made available to them.
5. There is shortage of Inspectors/staff members and the field enquiries are not possible in the absence of supporting staff team under the Assessing Officers. Due to shortage of Inspectors, the identification or making field enquiries are also made very difficult.
6. The present difficulties being faced by the Assessing Officers are squarely to be blamed on the source Directorate from where such data are being pushed into without any technical or

administrative support. The following difficulties are being faced by the Assessing Officers of Delhi Charge :-

- Lack of Technical support;
- Lack of ITD/ITBA database to identify correct address and jurisdiction;
- Data with the Assessing Officer who is not holding jurisdiction in many cases;
- Non migration of PAN due to technical reasons;
- Freezing of NMS data at one place where the AOs are not holding jurisdiction;
- Lack of Complete data with Assessing officers;
- Shortage of Inspectors to conduct field enquiry;

7. The above difficulties are being brought to your kind notice for immediate necessary action.
