Subject: Resolution wrt the convening of the BGM/Elections in the Regions– reg.

Ref. : The eMCM of ITGOA (CHQ) on 18th & 21st September, 2020

Kindly refer to the above.

2. During the e-Managing Committee Meeting (eMCM) of the ITGOA (CHQ.) held on 18th & 21st September, 2020 on Webex, it was brought to the knowledge of the Managing Committee by Shri Arun Kumar Sinha, Joint Secretary (HQ), ITGOA (CHQ) that the “Term of Office” of Delhi Unit got completed in January 2020, under the normal Course and the extended term of Office expired in April, 2020. Shri Sinha further informed to the august body that the BGM of the Delhi unit was scheduled on 17th March, 2020 but on account of the restrictions imposed by the State Govt. on all kinds of gatherings due to spread of pandemic of COVID 19, the BGM was postponed till the conditions get normalised. However, the situation remained the same till the date of eMCM, he added. He accordingly concluded by informing that the process of the election in Delhi unit of ITGOA could not be initiated even after lapse of 32 months from the last election. Similar kind of situation was reported by the Karnataka & Goa Unit and apprehension of such situation appearing in other regions were shown by the NWR and the Rajsathan Units, where elections would be due in the near future.

3. This issue was threadbare discussed by all the Managing Committee of the ITGOA (CHQ.) during the aforesaid eMCM and it was unanimously decided that the “Term of Office” of all the Units where the Elections to the ITGOA were due or would be due in the coming days, during this pandemic period, stand extended till the attainment of normalcy and removal of the restrictions on public gatherings by the Central MHA or the State MHAs or the respective State Governments or the local administrations.

4. This is for your kind information and necessary action.
